

HISTORY & HOW WE GOT HERE



- •2015: Council declaration: 100% Renewable Energy by 2050
- •2016: 100% RE Plan released as County-wide guidance document based on global Kassel criteria






WHAT HAS HAPPENED SINCE



- •2015-2019: High momentum and engagement
 - >E.g., "Build Better,"
 Blossom Park project,
 CUTRIC, IREA
- •2018: Update to 100% RE Plan
- 2020-Present: Loss of momentum stemming from pandemic, leadership and staffing changeover



WHERE WE ARE TODAY



- Oxford County Renewable Energy Plan approved by County Council for County operations (2022)
- Impact Network expansion to Oxford County
- Local businesses and organizations making their own commitments to carbon reduction (without awareness of alignment to common 100% RE goal)

WHAT ARE THE NEEDS?



- Updated community-wide plan
 - Re-commit as part of Strategic Plan update
- Updated community-wide inventory
- Broader education across the community
- Support of the Impact Network's recent expansion to Oxford County and Wellington from Waterloo Region
