- 6.2 Nathan Bean
Resident of Embro on behalf of concerned residents of Zorra Township
Re: Intersection of Oxford Road 6 and Road 96 (Oxford Road 28)

N. Bean joins the meeting in the Council Chamber and indicates that over the past three years, there have been two fatalities, numerous injuries, and countless collisions at the intersection of Oxford Road 6 and Road 96 (Oxford Road 28), with the most recent of these fatalities occurring on June 13, 2024, when a motorcyclist was struck and killed by an SUV. N. Bean requests that the planned installation of transverse rumble strips be installed as soon as possible to help reduce the number of collisions as it will give additional auditory warnings for motorists to slow down and prepare to stop. N. Bean also requests that the addition of flashing amber and flashing red signals be installed at this intersection.

N. Bean then indicates that although an exhaustive intersection control feasibility study is currently scheduled for 2026, he requests that the County move up the feasibility study to 2025.

N. Bean responds to comments and questions from Warden Ryan, Deputy Warden Peterson and Councillors Acchione, Gilvesy, Martin, Mayberry and Petrie.

 - c. Up to \$500,000 in development and up to \$150,000 in annual operating, to support a ten-bed transitional home at a future location in Woodstock, owned and operated by Assisted Living Care Homes (100045179 Ontario Inc.), subject to acquiring an appropriately zoned property by February 28, 2025.
2. And further, that County Council authorize the Chief Administrative Officer and the Director of Human Services to execute Municipal Housing Facilities Agreements and all other necessary documents related to the proposed housing projects owned and operated by CMHA, United Way Oxford/OCCHC and Assisted Living Care Homes;
3. And further, that County Council authorize the allocation of up to \$60,000 from the Human Services Budget, through New Initiative 2024-10 – Homelessness Response Strategy, for legal services related to the proposed projects contained in this report.
