




Which of the following statements describes your connection to *your Township/Town/City*? Please select all that apply.





Oxford County provides a wide range of services to support residents. The following questions are about services that are funded through Oxford County tax dollars and delivered by the County.

Please note: Municipal water and wastewater rates (charged through your utility bill) fully pay for water and wastewater services in all of Oxford's area municipalities.

Transportation Services - County Roads and Bridges

- •Transportation Services is responsible for transportation planning, traffic calming, and maintaining roads and bridges on Oxford's major roads and highways.
- •In 2023, the County maintained 1,335 lane kilometers of road, 163 bridge structures/ culverts, 39 signalized intersections, 5,562 regulatory and warning signs, and 13 controlled pedestrian crossings.
- •In 2023, 40 km roads were repaved, and staff responded to 54 winter events that either met or exceeded municipal service level standards.
- •According to the current Asset Management Plan, the condition of roads is rated as excellent and bridges are rated as good.
- •The 2024 Budget includes over \$12.2 million in capital contributions to the road network: Roads, Bridges and Stormwater. Capital reserves are built based on the lifecycle needs of existing assets identified in the Asset Management Plan.

Waste Management (Garbage and Recycling)

•Waste Management services include curbside collection for garbage and recycling, drop-off depots, large item collection, and services at the Oxford County Waste Management Facility in Salford.

handled was diverted from the landfill, including 16,710 tonnes of finished compost and over 7,900 tonnes of blue box recyclable materials.

•The estimated remaining life of the municipal landfill operated by Oxford County is approximately 27 to 32 years.

Human Services - Child Care and EarlyON

- •Child Care plans and manages quality child care through external partners across Oxford County. In 2023, 563 families and 649 children received assistance with their childcare fee.
- •EarlyON delivers free programs for parents and caregivers with children 0-6 years throughout the County. In 2023, 3,289 unique individuals were served through EarlyON programs, with 27,175 visits by parents/caregivers and children.

Human Services - Housing

- •Housing offers a variety of programs to help people who don't have suitable housing. According to the 2021 census, 4.8% of owner and tenant households in Oxford County are in core housing need, meaning the dwelling is considered unsuitable, inadequate or unaffordable, and whose income is such that they cannot afford alternative suitable and adequate housing in their community.
- •In 2023, the Housing program funded 628 Oxford County-owned public housing units, 656 not-for profit housing units, and 538 affordable housing units. The My Second Unit program was also supported.
- •In 2023, 48 rent supplements were provided and 60 applications for Canada-Ontario Housing benefit (COHB) were completed. These programs bridge the gap between the actual rent and rent affordable by the family/individual.

•The Homelessness Prevention Program (HPP) is a 100% provincially funded, outcomes-based program that offers supports to prevent, address and reduce homelessness, including chronic homelessness, by improving access to adequate, suitable, and affordable housing and support services for people at risk of or experiencing homelessness. This program has helped up to 1,500 people per year and has assisted with last month's rent; preventing evictions and utility disconnections; funding emergency shelter services at The Inn, Salvation Army Emergency House, motel and hotel stays as necessary; Supportive Housing programs; Community Outreach Services; and other agencies involved with housing and homelessness response throughout Oxford County.

Woodingford Lodge - Long-term Care in Woodstock, Ingersoll and Tillsonburg

- •Woodingford Lodge is an Oxford County owned and operated long-term care facility providing personal and healthcare services. Ontario's upper tier municipalities are required to operate at least one long-term care home under the Fixing Long Term Care Act, 2021, with the number of beds approved by the province.
- •In 2023, Woodingford received 35% of its funding from Oxford County property taxes, 49% from the Government of Ontario, and 16% from the long-term care residents who live in the home.
- •Woodingford Lodge provides a person-centred, resident-first model of care to 160 residents in Woodstock, 34 residents in Ingersoll and 34 residents in Tillsonburg. There are approximately 1,250 people on the waitlist between the three Woodingford Lodge homes.
- •Data from the 2021 Census shows that people 65 years and over represent 20% of Oxford's population.

Paramedic Services

- •Paramedic Services provides emergency care to stabilize a patient's condition, initiates rapid transport to hospitals (ambulance), and facilitates both emergency and non-emergency transfers between medical facilities.
- •Paramedic Services land ambulance receives approximately 50% of its funding from the Government of Ontario. The Community Paramedicine program is fully funded by the Government of Ontario.
- •In 2023, Paramedic Services responded to 19,297 emergency calls for service and 4,088 patient interactions in the Community Paramedicine program.

Community Planning

- •Community Planning provides professional advice and services to Oxford County and all eight Area Municipalities on the use of land, including but not limited to, planning for growth (i.e., residential, commercial and industrial) and the protection of agriculture and the broader natural environment.
- •Some of the specific services provided include developing and maintaining the Official Plan and Area Municipal Zoning By-laws; undertaking planning related special projects and studies; responding to development inquiries; professional planning review services for all development applications; maintaining planning related data and information; and development of mapping and other planning related resource materials.
- •Community Planning processes approximately 500 applications annually.

Wastewater Services


- •Oxford County operates and maintains 9 wastewater treatment plants, more than 630 km of sanitary sewers /forcemains, 38 sewage pumping stations, and two odour control facilities across 11 different municipal wastewater systems that service more than 37,000 customers.
- •In 2023, 13.6 million cubic metres of wastewater was treated.

Water Services

- •Oxford County operates and maintains 62 water supply wells, 17 water treatment systems, more than 753 km of watermains, 42 water reservoirs/towers, and 7 water booster stations across 17 municipal different drinking water systems that serve 21 communities across Oxford County.
- •In 2023, 10.7 million cubic metres of water was treated for both residential and commercial consumption.

That homelessness has become a visible issue in the urban centres of our county is shameful. That more than a thousand people in need of a room and care are currently assigned to a waiting list at the three Woodingford Lodge facilities is shameful. I realize that the County of Oxford has programs to try to address these challenges. But it needs -- we all need -- to do better. Why I selected "enhanced" for the Community Planning service category: More planning resources need to go towards the protection of our county's agricultural lands and natural environment. These lands should be considered sacrosanct by Oxford County's planners and its politicians. There is too much influence by developers in the planning process. I distrust developers because they rarely have the long-term public interest at heart. Withstanding their pressure requires political will and a stronger Official Plan, particularly where it involves Oxford County's farmlands, woodlands and wetlands. These irreplaceable areas will continue to be chipped away at by developers unless this county comes up with a vision and a solution for how to allow for "growth" while also curtailing urban sprawl. Maybe part of the answer is encouraging the building of more multiplexes and higher-rise housing and apartment structures within the current urban boundaries. Mass-produced subdivisions of ugly, cookie-cutter, single-family homes and McMansions on what were previously

working farms is outdated thinking and should be restricted. At the very least, in any new subdivision project, mixed forms of housing (e.g., multi-family dwellings along with single-family homes) should be permitted and supported. The idea here is that if land is to be sacrificed for housing, an effort will be made to lessen this sacrifice by seeking densification (which might help to avoid the sacrifice of other lands elsewhere). Lastly, if it doesn't already have one, the County should hire an environmental planner to help vet development applications and ensure that Oxford's natural heritage is always protected in the planning process for the citizens of both today and tomorrow. An additional note regarding question 10: I have given only a "fair" rating because of the 15% increase in the County of Oxford's portion of my property taxes for 2024. This seems like a shocking escalation. But then I have no clue about the reason for this increase, as the County has, in my opinion, done a less than adequate job in presenting its rationale to taxpayers. Could it not have at least provided some kind of insert in a utility bill explaining its position? I know there are inflationary pressures on government services, but I hope such an extraordinary percentage tax increase doesn't become a trend. After all, as a senior with a limited income, I'd like to be able to afford to remain in my own home as I continue to get older.





I would just make a request to Oxford County and Ingersoll politicians and staff to please be sensitive during their respective budget discussions to the fact that property tax increases resulting from their

decisions can have a real impact on those who are on a limited or fixed income but who are also blessed to have a house. Affordable housing is not just an issue about those who are facing the difficulty of acquiring a home -- although that issue is serious -- it is also about those who may be worried about the financial ability to stay in a home they already own. Steep property tax increases only exacerbate this worry and can threaten to turn it into reality. As for the problem of homelessness in Oxford County, might the building of a dormitory, possibly through a public-private partnership, help to contribute to a solution? The dormitory could be akin to a university residence hall, with a small room assigned to each individual occupant, and with a communal kitchen or dining room available for meals that are made by the residents. Each individual room would have enough space to accommodate a single bed, dresser, desk and window. Safe, separate areas in the building would be provided for different genders. No drugs or alcohol would be permitted on the premises. For some residents, this living arrangement might be a temporary step until they feel prepared and confident to fully reintegrate into their community. For others, it might offer a long-term stay. For all, it would at least provide a roof over their heads and a refuge from the elements. I don't have a funding suggestion for such an idea, but hopefully both the provincial governent and the private sector would get involved and provide support in dollars or in kind. As for the issue of affordable housing, could the use and promotion of "tiny homes" be part of the answer? These dwellings could be an entry point into the real estate market for some people (e.g., single persons, young couples, etc.) who are without the funds to buy an average-sized house. I have seen photos of these "tiny homes" and they can be quite tasteful in their design. I don't know why they couldn't be incorporated into subdivision projects; they would only need the zoning or by-law support of Oxford County and/or area municipality councils. If I could make one final suggestion to the County and the Town of Ingersoll, it would be this: Find a small place in your budgets every year for the planting of trees. By that I mean native trees (not exotic species or native cultivars) and lots of them. As much as some would choose to deny it, we humans are in the midst of climate change, and there is almost nothing that can help mitigate the negative effects of climate change more easily than the carbonabsorbing and oxygen-producing entities that are trees. They are simple to plant and cheap to buy (or grow from seed). And everybody loves them. (Well, maybe not civil engineers.) They benefit our communities in so many ways. And they can live for centuries. What a gift to ourselves, to future generations and to our planet.


