

DELMER – STUDY AREA



DELMER SPEED MANAGEMENT & ROAD SAFETY REVIEW – 2019 FINDINGS

- Posted speed (50km/h) was below TAC guidelines
- Excessive operating speeds identified
- No apparent speed related collision trends





DELMER - TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

Approved by County Council under report PW 2021-26 Implemented in June 2022

- Adjusted posted speed from 50 km/h to 60 km/h
- SFS were installed on east and west village limits
- Transverse pavement markings on OR 20 at village approaches



DELMER SPEED MANAGEMENT & ROAD SAFETY REVIEW – POST MONITORING

Post monitoring speed data collection – 2022, 2023, 2024

Key Findings:

East Leg

- Outgoing 85th percentile speeds reduced up to 14km/h (2023)
- Incoming 85th percentile speeds reduced up to 19km/h (2023)

West Leg

- Incoming 85th percentile speeds increased up to 13km/h (2022)
- Outgoing 85th percentile speeds increased up to 10km/h (2024)
- Incoming 85th percentile speed measured by SFS was below posted speed





RECOMMENDATIONS

- Installation of flexible centerline delineators at village limits and within 60 km/h zone
- Continued post monitoring/data sharing with Police












BEACHVILLE STUDY AREA



BEACHVILLE SPEED MANAGEMENT & ROAD SAFETY REVIEW – 2019 FINDINGS

- 85th percentile speeds were marginally excessive to excessive
- 60 km/h zones extended beyond limits of built up area
- Ineffective speed step-down transition zones (80-60-50 km/h)





BEACHVILLE - TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

Approved by County Council under report PW 2020-30

Implemented in December 2020

- Installed SFSs at 50 km/h speed zone limit approaches
- Elimination of 80-60-50 km/h speed transition (80 km/h limit was adjusted to limits of 50 km/h zone)

Approved by County Council under report PW 2020-30

Implemented in June 2022

- Adjustment of 50 km/h speed zone at west approach
- Shark Teeth pavement markings at approaches
- Centerline flexible delineators at approaches at the 50 km/h zone limits

Approved by County Council under report PW 2023-05

Implemented in November 2023

Road segment of OR9 east of Zorra line was designated as CSZ



Post monitoring speed data collection – 2022, 2023, 2024

Key Findings:

East end

- Incoming 85th percentile speeds reduced up to 11 km/h (2023)
- Outgoing 85th percentile speeds reduced up to 13 km/h (2022)

Within Village

 85th percentile speeds **reduced** for traffic in both the directions but excessive in relation to posted speed

West end

 Excessive approach speeds at start of 50 km/h zone but are reduced as vehicles approach SFS sign





RECOMMENDATIONS

- Flexible centerline delineators throughout 50 km/h zone
- Additional posted speed signs
- Automated Speed Enforcement in Community Safety Zone
- Continued post monitoring/data sharing with Police












VERSCHOYLE STUDY AREA



VERSCHOYLE SPEED MANAGEMENT & ROAD SAFETY REVIEW – 2023 FINDINGS

- Outgoing 85th percentile speeds were excessive at village limits
- Incoming 85th percentile speeds were marginally excessive at village limits
- Limits of 60 km/h zone was extended beyond the builtup limits of the village





VERSCHOYLE - TRAFFIC CALMING MEASURES

Approved by County Council under report PW 2023-28 Implemented in May 2024

- Installed flexible center line delineators at the village approaches
- Adjusted 60 km/h speed zone limits to align with the built-up area



Post monitoring speed data collection – 2024

Key Findings:

North End

Outgoing 85th percentile speed reduced by 12 km/h

South End

Outgoing 85th percentile speeds reduced by 13 km/h





RECOMMENDATIONS

- No further measures are recommended at this time
- Continued post monitoring/data sharing with Police
