WHEREAS The Government of Canada and the Federation of Canadian Municipalities (FCM) accepts no liability for the PCP program, leaving council members solely responsible for its endorsement and implementation, which:

- Guides councils' decision-making
- Costs staff hours, resources and fees
- Directs public funds and assets to private development goals
- Drives population growth to cities
- Targets mobility and privacy rights
- Impacts water and property rights, and
- threatens food and energy security

WHEREAS Participation in the PCP program is voluntary and Oxford County Council can withdraw at any time;
