COUNTY OF OXFORD

BY-LAW NO. 6322-2021

BEING a By-Law to remove certain lands from Part Lot Control.

WHEREAS, Hogg Excavating & Construction Ltd., has applied to the County of Oxford to delete, by by-law, certain lands for four (4) residential lots in a registered subdivision from Part Lot Control.

AND WHEREAS pursuant to subsection 59(1) of the County of Oxford Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter C.42, the County of Oxford may pass a by-law under subsection 50(7) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the County of Oxford enacts as follows:

1. Pursuant to subsection 50(7), subsection 50(5) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.13, as amended, does not apply to:

All of Block 36, Registered Plan 41M-347, being PARTS 1 & 2, designated on a Plan of Survey deposited in the Land Registry Office for Oxford No. 41 as Reference Plan 41R-10092, Township of Zorra, County of Oxford, comprising a total of two (2) parcels and all of Block 42, Registered Plan 41M-347, being PARTS 1 & 2, designated on a Plan of Survey deposited in the Land Registry Office for Oxford No. 41 as Reference Plan 41R-10082, Township of Zorra, County of Oxford, comprising a total of two (2) parcels, totalling four (4) parcels altogether, and each parcel to be conveyed to individual transferees in accordance with the following descriptions:

- i. Part of Block 36, Plan 41M-347, being PART 1, Plan 41R-10092, alone;
- ii. Part of Block 36, Plan 41M-347, being PART 2, Plan 41R-10092, alone;
- iii. Part of Block 42, Plan 41M-347, being PART 1, Plan 41R-10082, alone; and
- iv. Part of Block 42, Plan 41M-347, being PART 2, Plan 41R-10082, alone.
- 2. Pursuant to subsection 50 (7.3) of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.13, as amended, **this By-Law shall expire on March 24, 2022** unless it shall have prior to that date been repealed or extended by the Council of the County of Oxford.
- 3. That after the lots or any portion thereof have been conveyed to individual transferees this By-Law may be repealed by the Council of the County of Oxford.
- 4. That this By-Law shall become effective on the date of third and final reading.
