> To amend the special Business Park policy area adjacent to the Brick Wetlands to include a small-scale truck terminal with parking for up to 16 transport trucks as a permitted use on a portion of the said lands municipally known as 1055 Parkinson Road, in the City of Woodstock.

> The Chair asks Gord Hough, Director of Community Planning to present the application. G. Hough summarizes the application as contained in Report No. CP 2021-116 - Application for Official Plan Amendment OP 20-20-8 - Davinder Grewal, Harvarinder Sidhu & Kuldeep Singh.

G Hough, through use of a map, indicates that the application for Official Plan Amendment in which the Applicant is proposing to redesignate a portion of the lands to facilitate the development of a small-scale truck operation comprising of an approx. 11,000 sq. ft. building and parking for up to sixteen vehicles. G. Hough indicates that the lands are currently designated for business park use. The application proposes the lands be redesignated to allow the truck operation as an additional use in the business park designated for the trucking operation is approximately 2.2 acres of which the remaining eight acres to the north of the property is

associated with the Brick Pond Wetland, are identified as environmentally protected and are intended to remain as so, adding that this application includes a City of Woodstock zoning application to zone the lands as Environmental Protection to ensure they are in keeping with the underlying designation. In closing, G. Hough indicates that staff are in support of the application and that City of Woodstock Council have recommended approval of the application.
