The Ontario Municipal Management Institute is a non-profit association established in 1979 by Ontario's local governments, associations, the provincial government, and academic institutions to promote management development through recognition and training of local government staff, supervisors and managers.

The Certified Municipal Manager (CMM) Accreditation Program recognizes education and employment experience, with four levels of the CMM designation, while providing a personal development analysis with a guiding framework, to encourage broadening members' career development.

In June 1988, the passage in the Ontario Legislature of Bill PR27, accorded full legal status and recognition to the CMM accreditation. Over sixteen hundred awards include thirty professions in the local government sector, from front line staff to senior management.

A number of recent, expanded partnerships, with the support of 14 Local Government Professional Associations provide opportunities for profession-specific *enhancements*, complementing the CMM. The enhancements help our partners address the accreditation needs of their members.
