Financing 2020-2021

- 2 loans disbursed at \$125,000
- 6 jobs created/maintained



Since inception (2016)

Total Loans

- ▶ 12 loans in the amount of \$698,613
- > \$2,117,100 of owner's investment
- > \$5,346,790 of third-party investment
- \$7,463,890 of total investment
- ▶ 168 jobs impacted



Grants 2020-2021

- ► 4 grants disbursed at \$8,695
- ▶ 15 partners that invested \$35,925



Since inception (2016)

Total Grants

- ▶ 22 grants in the amount of \$29,130
- ▶ 74 partners invested \$174,738











▶ A fund created in May of 2020 to address the challenges faced by businesses due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

- Disbursement break out over 2 years:
- ▶ \$1,200,000 for loans
- ▶ \$180,000 for grant projects

- ▶ 12 grants in the amount of \$175,873 approved
- ▶ 21 partners invested \$104,729



- Continue with the Administrative Payments to Community Futures Oxford.
- Continue with the \$100,000 investment to the Future Oxford Legacy Fund each year for the next five years.
- Note: We have consulted with County Staff.



Partnership Agreement

New Term:

- ▶ 5 years starting January 1, 2022 to December 31, 2026.
- ► Fiscal period to remain the same: January 1 to December 31.

- ► The fund continues to promote the pillars of the Community Sustainability Plan.
- ► The fund complements our other programs including Thrive Oxford, a women's entrepreneurship program.



Plan for the Oxford Economic Stimulus Fund:

- Continue to promote the loans and disburse the original funded amount into 2022.
- Potentially merge the Oxford Economic Stimulus Fund and Future Oxford Legacy Fund in 2022.
