Year of transition and refocusing

- •6 new members appointed in fall of 2021, joining six incumbents
- Extended vacancy (8 months) for County's Manager of Strategic Initiatives & Continuous Improvement role
- Two election periods



OXFORD COVID-19 REPSONSE SURVEY

- Hosted information session for community partners in June to share high-level findings
- Study noted significant decline in mental health during the COVID-19 pandemic; final research still to be published
- Infographic and summary materials in development

- Supporting Oxford County's Renewable Energy Action Plan

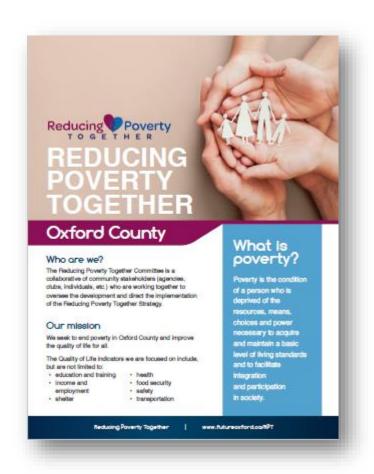
